Revising: Study tips



Understanding the content: Take time to understand the information in your notes. Read over the content before you create a revision aid or attempt a past paper question.



Red, Amber and Green: Do you know the course content for each of your subjects? What do you need to know for each topic? Create topic checklists before you begin revising and use a traffic light system to prioritise your revision-

- ✓ Red for an area you must revisit as you remember little of this or found it difficult.
- ✓ Amber for an area you are fairly confident in, but you are still uncertain in areas.
- ✓ Green for areas you are confident in and are performing well in past paper questions.



Method: Find what works for you. Have a look at the different revision strategies in this booklet and try as many as you can.

Take breaks: Study for a set period of time and then take a break to prevent burnout.



summary

Condense: Summarise key information as much as possible as it is easier to understand and revise in the lead up to exams.

Get creative: Add colour, diagrams and highlight key phrases to help you to remember important points.
